What Happens When the Gospel is Boldly Proclaimed
Acts 19.1-20

WHEN THE GOSPEL IS BOLDLY PROCLAIMED...

...there is theological precision in our evangelism, leading to powerful conversions (1-7)

Drilling down on doctrine in order to determine whether there is conversion (1-3)

Moving them past religious shadows to the substance of all revelation (4-5)

The power of the Holy Spirit is always attendant with salvation (6-7)

WHEN THE GOSPEL IS BOLDLY PROCLAIMED...

...there will be an apologetic divide in our ministries and power to drive away the darkness (8-12).

There will always be those who believe...(8)

...and there will always be those who are hostile (9a)

Hostility can lead to new evangelistic trajectories (9b)

WHEN THE GOSPEL IS BOLDLY PROCLAIMED...

...the unseen world will manifest, confronting us with our cultural and religious idols (13-20)

What happens when self-appointed spiritual powerbrokers trifle with the supernatural powers (13-14)

What happens when the appearance of unseen darkness drives people to the refuge of Christ (15-18).

What happens when the cost of repentance is a delightful response to the gospel (19).

What happens when the Word of God is boldly proclaimed for 3 years (20).
